



Acquisition: New collaboration between AIRESIS and MOVEMENT group

AIRESIS SA (AIRE), an investment company whose shares are listed on the Swiss Exchange (SIX: AIRE) and MOVEMENT group announce that they found an agreement for the purchase of 92% of MOVEMENT group by Airesis.

MOVEMENT group employs about 120 people and consists mainly of two companies: WILD DUCK, who owns the brand MOVEMENT and CASOAR, which is a distribution company based in Switzerland. Movement Group has a total turnover of around CHF 15 million.

The acquisition of MOVEMENT group is in the scope of Airesis' strategy. Airesis wishes to support the development of the ski company from the Vaud Region in Switzerland. Movement's current management will stay involved, especially with Serge Baud as a shareholder. Mr Baud, currently CEO of the company, is the co-founder of the brand with whom he has been working for 13 years. Thus, the current strategy will remain and will be supported by Airesis.

A synergy between CASOAR and Le Coq Sportif will enable the French brand to use Casoar' Swiss distribution network to develop Le Coq Sportif in Switzerland.
